The Winsemius Awards represent the most prestigious form of recognition on Collaboration, Business Achievements, Innovation and Social Responsibility for companies who have Sustainability in the core of what they do.

The Winsemius Awards 2022 winners are:

Winsemius Community Impart Award

The Community Impact Award recognizes and honors companies' commitment to positively impacting the Singaporean community with tangible results by creating significant financial, social or environmental value for the benefit of a community.

Short summary of the winning case

Arcadis - Community Garden Program - WeGardens+

In early 2020, migrant workers in Singapore were badly affected by Covid-19 pandemic. The migrant workers faced a lot of challenges and hardship inclusive of movement and interaction restrictions. At this juncture, Arcadis had globally launched a COVID-19 Recovery Program to provide funding to support local communities in the recovery of COVID-19. Arcadis Singapore collaborated with the Covid 19 Migrant Worker Support Coalition (CMSC) and developed the WeGarden+ programme:

- Providing edible portable garden to migrant workers aims to improve the mental health, nutrition, and wellbeing of dormitory residents.
- Engagement with migrant workers through social media provide a platform to share their gardening skills and learn from local gardening communities.



• Piloting installation of solar panels in a dormitory - by introduce & demonstrate sustainable methods of dormitory operation.

Arcadis Singapore is providing funding and rendering project management services to delivering the WeGarden+ programme. To date, we have successfully set up edible gardens in 8 dormitories. As a result, our partner, CMSC plans to add 5 more dormitories for implementation of edible gardens. With the idea of solar panels, we hope that dorm operators will see the potential and will be inspired to adopt sustainable methods of dorm operation. Winning the Winsemius Community Impact Award 2022 motivates us to do more to improve the quality of life of communities around us.

The Red Orange Award highlights the importance of the long standing and ongoing relationship between The Netherlands and Singapore and celebrates businesses that create value by collaboration for both the Singaporean and Dutch business community.

Royal Vopak is the world's leading independent tank storage company. We store vital products with care. With over 400 years of history and a focus on sustainability, we ensure safe, clean and efficient storage and handling of bulk liquid products and gases for our customers. By doing so, we enable the delivery of products that are vital to our economy and daily lives, ranging from chemicals, oils, gases and LNG to biofuels and vegoils. We are developing key infrastructure solutions for the world's changing energy and feedstock systems, while simultaneously investing in digitalization and innovation. Vopak is listed on the Euronext Amsterdam and is headquartered in Rotterdam, the Netherlands.

Short summary of the winning case

Vopak has successfully prototyped and validated the use of a vanadium-based flow battery in its industrial facilities on Jurong Island, Singapore. Compared to conventional lead/li-ion batteries, vanadium-based flow battery has a longer lifespan, offers long-duration storage, and is non-flammable, making it suitable for industrial-scale applications. It also has better sustainability and circularity profile. The prototype battery setup combined with remote control and system monitoring, allows the system to be flexibly configured to serve a variety of energy load combinations and demands in a safe, controlled manner. This is a crucial solution to potentially enable the energy transition for existing industrial facilities and make the energy supply more reliable. Vopak is proud to be part of Singapore's innovative ecosystem and contribute to the development and refinement of such new technological solutions. This brings us one step closer to a sustainable future for existing industries.
